DIAGNOSIS

Large VSD

S/P : VSD closure done on 22/11/2021

CLINICAL HISTORY

History:

Term/NVD/hospital birth /normal birth weight/cried imm after birth/no NICU admission.He was diagnosed as VSD at age of 6 months,when he was admitted for neumonia.H/O multiple admissions for pneumonia and CHF.H/o poor weight gain present.

PHYSICAL EXAMINATION

Pulse: 131/min. BP: 137/82 mmHg Temperature: 36.5 degree C Weight: 14 Kg. Height: 108 cm.

General Examination:

Child was conscious, oriented, afebrile.

No pallor, icterus, clubbing, cyanosis, lymphadenopathy or oedema.

Systemic examination:

RS - Chest clear bilaterally. Air entry equal. No crepitations or wheeze.

CVS - Heart sounds normal. PSM+ grade 4 over left sternal border

P/A -Abdomen is soft, not tender and not distended. No hepatosplenomegaly. Bowel sounds are normal.

CNS - Child was conscious and oriented. Muscle tone and reflexes are normal. Plantars are down-going. No signs of meningeal irritation. Pupils are normal sized and normally reactive to light bilaterally

CLINICAL SUMMARY

Child was admitted and after pre-operative workup, child was taken up for procedure. Child was shifted to PCS ICU.

Hemodynamics: Child required inotropic support which was gradually weaned.child developed hypertension, which was managed post operatively with SNP infusion , later on oral antihypertensives.

Respiratory: Child was received extubated, on O2 by mask.Child developed minimal drain outputs which improved subsequently and drains were removed before discharge.

Infection: Recieved supacef 3 doses.

Gastrointestinal and nutrition: no issues.



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Neurological: Child remained stable with no significant past history.

Present status: Currently patient is haemodynamically stable, maintaining saturation on room air without any distress, accepting feed orally and is being discharged with advice to follow-up.

Predischarge weight-14.2 kg

Predischarge ECHO- LVEF-30% Mild AR/Mild MR; Trace PE (4 mm post to LV); No residual VSD

DISCHARGE ADVICE

CARDIAC MEDICATIONS- (duration to be decided in opd follow up)

1. Syp Europed 1 ml BD ..6 am - 6 pm
2. TAB Aquazide (12.5 mg) 1 tb P/O BD ..10 am- 10 pm
3. TAB Envas (2.5 MG) 1 TAB P/O BD..8 am - 8 pm
4. Tab Amlong 2.5 mg 1/2 tab P/O BD .. 12 pm - 12 am

NON CARDIAC MEDICATIONS -

1. SYRUP CALPOL (250MG/5ML) 4.5 ML P/O THRICE A DAY FOR 3 DAYS F/B SOS (For pain and temperature >100° F)
2. SYRUP CALCIMAX PLUS 5 ML P/O TWICE A DAY
3. SYP Bevon 5 ml P/O OD

1. Stitch removal on: Discharge
