#### FINAL DIAGNOSIS AT DISCHARGE:-

Down's Syndrome / Large PM VSD / Severe PAH

#### PRESENTING COMPLAINTS:-

1 Years Old Female was admitted with case of large malaligned perimembranous VSD small PDA, Left sided volume overload and severe PAH.

Now he is admitted for further evaluation and management.

#### EXAMINATION ON ARRIVAL:-

Weight On Admission:- 5 kg

Temperature: 97.6 Degree Fahrenheit,

Heart rate: 130 /min,

Respiratory Rate: 22/min,

SPO2: 97 % on Room Air,

Chest: Bilateral air entry (+),

Per Abdomen: Soft, BS (+),

Cardiovascular System: S1S2 (+), ESM(+)

Weight On Discharge:- 4.5 kg

#### COURSE DURING HOSPITAL STAY:-

On admission, she was thoroughly evaluated. All relevant investigations were done (Report attached). 2D Echo was done, which confirmed the diagnosis.

In view of her diagnosis, symptomatic status and echo findings, she was advised early VSD closure + Decompressing PFO.

Her father was counseled in detail about the natural history of the disease and the risk & benefits of surgery were also explained in detail. The possibility of prolonged ventilator requirement and ICU stay were also adequately explained.

After due high risk consent, she was taken for the surgery on 15.09.2025.

**PROCEDURE:** VSD closure + Decompressing PFO under GA on 15.09.2025

Post operatively, she was shifted to Pediatric CTVS ICU for further management. 1 Unit PRBC, 1 Unit FFP and 1 Unit SDP was transfused. She was electively ventilated with adequate sedation & analgesia. She was extubated on 1st POD to HFNC. Gradually HFNC was weaned and baby put on oxygen by Nasal Prongs on 3rd POD, Oxygen was then gradually weaned off to room air by 4th POD.

Associated bilateral basal patchy atelectasis and concurrent bronchorrhea was managed with chest physiotherapy, nebulization and postural drainage.

She was electively supported with inotropes in the form of Adrenalin (0-1st POD), Dobutamine (0-1st POD), Milrinone (0-2nd POD), to optimize initial low cardiac output state.

Decongestives were used in the form of Furosemide boluses. Spironolactone was used for its potassium sparing effects. Now patient is being discharged in stable condition.

**POST OPERATIVE ECHO FINDINGS:-**

PFO (L-R)  
VSD patch in situ  
Mild TR / max PG 38mmhg  
LVEF ~ 40%  
No pericardial / pleural collection

**DISCHARGE MEDICATION:-**

Syp. Cepodem (100mg/5ml) 1.5ml twice daily  
Syp. Calcimax P 2.5ml once daily  
Foroped Drop 0.5ml thrice daily  
Tab. Aldactone 6.125mg 1 tab once daily  
Syp. Crocin 5ml thrice daily  
Tab. Lanzol JR 5mg 1 tab once daily
